1977-78 When Saunders came to Parkland he faced the same problem he had at Anderson High; he couldn't

play running back because Settle and Peterson had now been joined by a hard running back Chris Kirkpatrick Coach Homer Thompson made Saunders the first running quarterback at Parkland, the play was called the Stampede and basically it's just a power sweep. "Saunders is a powerful runner". Coach Homer Thompson)

With Kirkpatrick and Buford out with injuries, Saunders got his chance and took full advantage, at tailback he lead the team to a 24-6 playoff victory. For his performance he was named The Sentinel Player of the Week and

given the nickname of "THE BULL."

1978-79 Saunders senior year he was bullish on every team. He gained 1178 yards and scored 12 touchdowns, he was

voted Parkland's top Running back, All City-County and selected to the Super 25 Offensive team.

After High School Saunders became a Golden Bull at Johnson C. Smith, where he was a running back and earned a BA in Liberal Arts.
